RULES OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. Awards are confined to those young people who are aged between 13 and 21 years.
- 2. Nomination Form should be typed where possible.
- 3. Permanent residence of the young person must be in the Garda Division in which they are nominated.
- 4. Awards are confined to individuals and groups of two or more people.
- 5. Judges decision is final.
- 6. Any member of the public may nominate anyone whom they feel deserves an award.
- 7. As much information as possible should be supplied by nominators in respect of nominees and why you think they deserve an award.
- 8. Nominations may be submitted by family members or relatives.
- 9. Previous award winners are not eligible.
- 10. Forms must be signed by nominator.
- 11. Please note that the Garda Youth Awards at Divisional and National level will receive media attention. Each award winner must sign a publication consent form. If consent is not given, you will still receive your award, but we will not be in a position to publicise you receiving the award at the award ceremony.
- 12. Every Young Person nominated for the Sligo/Leitrim Garda Division Awards will be formally acknowledged for their contribution and participation in this initiative.
- 13. Details of all nominees will be retained for a period not exceeding 6 months after the closing date; at which time details will be destroyed, in compliance with General Data Protection Regulations.
